AUTHORITY

Roughly quadrangular pillar stone - local old red sandstone.
Latin inscription "DERRAC - FILIVS / IUST - (H)IC IACIT"
(The Stone) of Derracus, son of Justus. He lies here.

5th - early 6th cent. AD. The position of the stone
suggests a roadside burial in the Roman manner.

Re-set in its original hole by Cyril Fox.
